



Social Media Policy

POLICY STATEMENT:

All participation in social media that involves the Livonia Storm must be conducted with respect and in a manner intended to safeguard the confidential information of our participants.

SCOPE:

This policy applies to all participants in the Livonia Storm who create or contribute to blogs, wikis, social networks, virtual worlds or any type of Social Media. Examples include but are not limited to: Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, SnapChat, Vine, or Yelp.

GUIDELINES:

1. Postings should not disclose any information that is confidential or which pertains to individuals, volunteer parents or children.
2. Internet postings should not include the Livonia Storm logo.
3. Do not post negative comments or pictures regarding any aspect of the Livonia Storm program. This includes but is not limited to coaching, officiating, parents, staff or participants.
4. The use of profanity or otherwise offensive language in any post is strictly prohibited.
5. Comments that are posted that are false or that can be construed as harassment or bullying will not be tolerated.

MONITORING AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

The failure to comply with the above guidelines may result in removal of the participant from the Livonia Storm program.

Concerns regarding any aspect of the Livonia Storm program should be immediately brought to the attention of the President of the Livonia Storm.
