



Parents Code of Ethics:

- I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by adhering to this Parents' Code of Ethics Pledge and any other policies, rules and regulations that may be adopted or imposed from time to time by the Livonia Storm, the Western Wayne County Girls Fast Pitch Softball League, the USSSA and any other applicable governing organization.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will, for the safety of my child, (1) strictly comply with all applicable requirements concerning the utilization of protective equipment, and (2) follow the recommendations of the Livonia Storm and other applicable governing organizations concerning the utilization of protective equipment.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and I will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- I will remember that the game is for the youth and not for the adults.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials, with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- I promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectable fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.
- I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach uphold the Coaches' Code of Ethics.
- I will read the NYSCA National Standards for Youth Sports and do what I can to help all youth sports organizations implement and enforce them.
